

Keep Meds Safe

Keep medication somewhere where children can't reach them, like a high cabinet or in a locked cabinet or safe.

OUT OF REACH



Never leave pill bottles or pills on a counter top, table or bedside table where children can reach them.

NO EASY ACCESS



At home talk with your children about keeping medicines in safe places and not taking medicine without an adult giving it.

HOME EDUCATION



At home or while traveling, keep medicines in their original, child resistant containers.
